JOINTLY DEVELOPED

The parents, students, and staff of Juniata Park Academy partnered together to develop this school-parent compact for achievement. Teachers suggested home learning strategies, parents added input about the types of support they needed, and students told us what would help them learn. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PHILADELPHIA ANCHOR GOALS:

- 1. 100% of students will graduate, ready for college and career.
- 2. 100% of 8-year-olds will read on grade level.
- 3. 100% of schools will have great principals and teachers.
- 4. SDP will have 100% of the funding we need for great schools, and zero deficit.

Juniata Park Academy GOALS:

- Increase the percentage of students grades K-3 reading at or above target level by 5% between quarters 1 and the end of the year as measured by DRA 2
- Increase the average percent of Math benchmark question answered correctly by 3% over the course of the year in grades 3-8 as measured by Benchmark data.
- In reading standardized testing, the "all students " group scoring proficient and advanced will be increased to an overall score of 49%. In math standardized testing, the "all students" group scoring proficient or advanced will increase to an overall score of 58%.
- 15 % of all PVAAS reported grade levels will have met or exceeded the standard for PA Academic Growth in all tested subjects and reading.
